


Patches, patches, and more patches. This is the theme of the day, at least for the time being.

HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN: Bones



Some basic hand signals everyone in a group ride should know. —Bones



Left turn Arm and hand extending left, palm facing down



Right turn Arm out, bent at 90° angle, fist clinched.



Stop Arm extended straight down, palm facing back.



Speed Up Arm extended straight out, palm facing up, swing upward.



Slow Down Arm extended straight out, palm facing down, swing down to your side.



Follow Me Arm extended straight up from shoulder, palm forward.



You Lead/Come Arm extended upward 45°, palm forward pointing with index finger, swing in arc from back to front.



Hazard in Roadway On the left, point with left hand; on the right, point with right foot.



Single File Arm and index finger extended straight up.



Double File Arm with index and middle finger extended straight up.



Comfort Stop Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion.



Refreshment Stop Fingers closed, thumb to mouth,



Turn Signal On Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



Pull Off Arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder.



Cops Ahead Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



Fuel Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger extended.

RIDING WITH A PASSENGER:


Spring is coming and everybody wants a ride on your motorcycle! Here are the rules regarding riding with a passenger... GA Code 40-6-311(a) states: A person operating a motorcycle shall ride only upon the permanent and regular seat attached. Another person may not ride on a motorcycle unless designed to carry more than one person. The seat must either be designed for two people, or another seat firmly attached to the motorcycle at the rear or side of the operator.

State law prohibits a passenger riding in front of the operator, or in any position that will interfere with the operation or control of the motorcycle or the view of the operator.

Motorcycles carrying passengers are also required to have footrests for the passengers as outlined in 40-6-314(a), unless equipped with a sidecar or enclosed cab.

Backrests are not required by law for passengers; however, certain backrests or "sissy bars" are prohibited as specified in 40-6-314(b): No person shall operate any motorcycle... with a backrest more commonly known as a sissy bar that is designed in such a way as to create a sharp point at its apex. See examples...
